

LANE RESTRICTIONS

96th St between Sepulveda Blvd and Bellanca Ave

Friday, October 4 at 11PM through Monday, October 7 at 11PM

ACTIVITY

To facilitate roadway striping by the Automated People Mover Project, 96th St between Sepulveda Blvd and Bellanca Ave will experience phased lane restrictions beginning Friday, October 4 at 11PM through Monday, October 7 at 11PM. Crews will begin at Sepulveda Blvd and work east down 96th St toward Bellanca Ave. Lane restrictions will also be in place on a portion of Airport Blvd at 96th St while striping is installed at this area.

Traffic will be maintained via open lanes or, when necessary, detours. When detours are needed, flaggers and signage will be in place to facilitate vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Please watch for posted signage, use caution when traveling near construction areas, and plan ahead for potential delays.

Please note: Upon completion of striping installation, 96th St will reopen for traffic. The portion of 96th St between Vicksburg Ave and Airport Blvd will be eastbound only. Access is maintained for businesses at this area.
